What does LITE do?

Living in Transition Effectively, Inc. was launched in 2019 to create relationships inside the Kosciusko County Jail with those preparing to reenter our community. It has grown into a Recovery Community Organization (RCO). It works inside the jail and out of the Milford Methodist Meeting House.



Inside KCJ we offer writing & mindfulness classes, job readiness, GED prep, parent courses, and we take care of the library. Our volunteers take the library cart to each block weekly. We administer assessments and help with reentry needs.



LITE Recovery Café is an emerging member of the Recovery Café Network. This is a peer led safe space welcoming of all who identify as being in recovery. We are a membership driven community which embraces all pathways to recovery.

Membership costs nothing but requires participating in a circle, a meal, sharing the work of the café itself, and taking classes.

LITEhouse opened in April 2023 as a residential recovery program for women. Our focus is on women leaving incarceration. This is a year long program. If we are not a good fit for a particular applicant we work to place them in a program which is a good fit.
